#### **Universal Periodic Review reporting deadlines**

The Universal Periodic Review (UPR) is a review of the human rights records of all 193 United Nations Member States once every four years. The goal is to improve the human rights situation in all countries and address human rights violations wherever they occur.

The UPR is one of the best ways for IFUW and its NFAs to influence governments. NFAs in Turkey and Sweden have expressed an interest in following the process. All NFAs, please <u>email the office</u> if you wish to get involved and if you need information or assistance. You may have already received the reporting deadline information below from UN sources.

15 June 2014: Deadline to submit stakeholder reports for UPR 21st session (to be held in January 2015) NFA countries: Spain, Kenya, Armenia, Sweden, Turkey

21 July 2014: Deadline to submit national reports by States to be reviewed at UPR 20th session (27 October – 7 November 2014)

NFA countries: Italy, Fiji, Slovenia, Egypt

15 September 2014: Deadline to submit stakeholder reports for UPR 22nd session (to be held in April 2015)

NFA countries: Panama, Bulgaria, USA, Croatia

#### **Working against Trafficking**

The <u>United Nations Human Rights Council</u> will announce its appointment of a new 'Special Rapporteur on trafficking in persons, especially women and children' at the 26<sup>th</sup> Human Rights Council from 10-27 June 2014. IFUW members who work on IFUW resolution on <u>Working against Trafficking</u> might wish to consult the <u>list of applicants and their biographies</u> for their own advocacy purposes.
