### Discrimination against women in law and practice

The <u>Working Group on Discrimination against Women in Law and in Practice</u> of the United Nations <u>Human Rights Council</u> calls for submissions from NFAs regarding equality and non-discrimination in

The World Bank shines a spotlight on the value of enabling women and girls to fulfill their potential and of amplifying their voices in a report entitled "Voice and Agency: Empowering Women and Girls for Shared Prosperity". The report highlights the constraints that girls and women face worldwide such as domestic violence, sexual and reproductive health and discriminatory property ownership laws. The report reviews promising policies and interventions with wide potential for development. Women's ability to make decisions and act on them independently has concrete value and advancing agency for women and girls should be central to any development agenda.
